BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING

Darcy Library of Beulah February 8, 2016

Call to Order: President Dennis Pace called the regular Board of Trustees meeting to order at 5:33 PM at the Darcy Library in Beulah, Michigan. Those in attendance and constituting a quorum were:

Minutes: January 11, 2016 minutes were reviewed. Hook moved to approve the minutes, Downs supported and the minutes were approved.

Treasurer's Report

- Monthly financial report for 7 months-ended January 31, 2016. (See attached) The seven month loss was \$1,118 vs \$11,473 budgeted. The variance is the same as the prior month.
- Received about \$30,396 of the total budgeted property taxes of \$58,000 in January. The difference will be received in subsequent months.
- The 2016 Overdrive eBooks cost of \$2,000 has been paid. The amount for the last six months of 2016 (\$1,000) is shown as a prepaid expense for the next fiscal year on the balance sheet. Since Overdrive did not start until October 1, 2015, the cost for the current fiscal year will be \$1,500 instead of \$2,000. This leaves \$500 of the \$2,000 paid by the Friends to be carried-over as deferred income on the balance sheet.
- Approval of the financial report was moved by Downs, Hook supported, the motion was approved.
- Request approval of unpaid bills (\$710.14) and paid bills January 14 to February 8, 2016 (\$4396.38) since the last meeting per attached lists.
- Approval of paid and unpaid bills was moved by Hook, Hahn supported, the motion was approved.

- Over 70 people attended the Business After Hours held at the library on January 21.
- Projector and DVD player are up and running, movie nights are going well
- Off the Page (OTP) is nearly complete, dates need to be firmed up
